



AB RUNDVIRKE'S INVESTMENT IN A NEW SAWLINE

AB Rundvirke's investment in a new sawline, which were announced in spring of 2008, has now started.

The major part of the suppliers are decided.

Loghandling with logdeck, log conveyors, log turner, bark handling and butreducer
Ingenjörfirma Gösta Hedlund AB, Alfta.

Sawline with 3-D scan, full optimization, chipper canter, bandsaws, integrated splitting-line and a debarker, Söderhamn Eriksson AB, Söderhamn

Greensortingline with vane-scanner, tray sorter, stick robot and an automatic sticker-stacker, Alfab AB, Storsvik.

The machines will be delivered end of 2009/beginning of 2010. The montage is calculated for approximately 3 months and test run will begin beginning of summer 2010.

AB Rundvirke will in total invest approximately 120 million SEK in the sawmill at Marmaverken, which will result in further improvement of the company and its subsidiary AT Träkomponent AB's positions as suppliers of high quality solid window scantlings. In year 2007 AT made an investment of about 22 million SEK in a new production line for glulam window scantlings.

The investment will be a change of technology, from a frame saw and separate splitting-line to a bandsaw line with an integrated splitting-line. AB Rundvirke is calculating to increase the production with approximately 40 percent from today's level.

AB Rundvirke and AT Träkomponent AB, are part of AB Borgen Group, and employs about 80 people. The production units are located in Marmaverken, Kilafors and Edsbyn.
